Break the Boundary has been successfully operating since 2013, as the only community group that helps Australians with a disability live a healthier and happier life through adaptive off-road cycling. We registered as a WA NFP Association on 25 January 2018 and this month registered as an official Australian Charity to prepare and function with the growing demand of events and users.

We have previously operated on the generous and selfless contributions of many supporters from the community; from support riders, general hands and in administration. The demand for more programs, events and clinics continues to increase and therefore we need to expand!

Recently we have been approaching different stakeholders and potential sponsors to:


- Own and manage our own adaptive off-road cycles, so we're not having to hire personal equipment that's not always available.
- Have better access to a variety of cycles to cater for a wider range of disabilities.
- Customised transport and trailer to cater people with limited mobility and able to be operated by people with disabilities.
- Build storage in key locations to cut down on transporting costs and provide members a taste of all the equipment in one convenient place.

These are a few of the items needed to meet our objectives and service the community.

Unfortunately, we have a limited financial record since our official incorporation in January. We have previously operated through other clubs and associations. This makes it difficult for us to show the grant coordinators our capacity to service the equipment. Queue the chicken and egg dilemma: we need our own equipment to run more programs to raise our own revenue to service the equipment.

After many sleepless nights, we've come up with a solution...

If we can find a MTB mechanic (or two) who can donate basic components and a few hours each month to give our future cycles a full service, we'll be able to go back to the grant coordinators with a plan on how we are going to sustain the function of the cycles.
